DISCOVERY BIBLE STUDY

LOOKING BACK

Opening Prayer: Share something you are grateful for or a challenge you are facing.

What did God say? Share what you sense God has showed you in His Word since the last meeting.

What did you do about it? Share how you have been obedient to God this week. Talk about the "I will" statement you made at the previous meeting.

LOOKING UP

Read: Read the passage aloud as people follow it in their Bibles.

Re-read: Have someone else read the same passage aloud as the group listens.

Retell: Ask someone to retell the passage in their own words. If necessary, ask the group to add to the summary.

Reflect: Ask discovery questions to interact with the passage:

- What did you like about this passage?
- Did anything in this passage bother you? Why?
- What does this passage teach us about God?
- What does this passage teach us about people?
- Is there an example to follow?
- Is there a mandate to follow or action to take?
- Is there a sin to avoid?
- Is there a promise to hold on to?
- With whom should you share this truth?

Ask: What do you sense God is revealing to your heart? How is God calling you to greater obedience this week? What will you do this week in response to what God has shown you?

LOOKING FORWARD

Obey: Write an "I will" statement based on what you received from the Holy Spirit and his Word.

Share: Share your "I will" statement of what you will do this week.
